RE: Automatic Meter Reading Equipment

Dear Property Owner:

As mentioned in previous correspondence the city has been working on installing new water meters which use automatic reading technology. This department has been notified that you have plumbing issues that need to be addressed and that the curb stop/box in your yard does not work properly or cannot be located so that the new meter can be installed.

THE INSTALLATION OF THIS METER IS MANDATORY. Therefore, there are two options which can be used to repair your curb box :

- 1) you can hire your own licensed and bonded contractor who is on file with the city to repair the curb stop and install a new curb box and rod. If you choose to have your own contractor make the repair, it must be done and reported to the plumbing inspector on or before Friday October 16, 2009.
- 2) the city will be entering into an agreement with a plumbing contractor to repair the curb stop/box. If the city makes the repair any and all costs will be assessed against you, and if unpaid, a lien will be placed on your property. The city will allow you to make payments or take payments in full (cash or check) or accept Visa, Discover or MasterCard.
