**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-5-10, ENTITLED "RULES OF ORDER," OF CHAPTER 5, ENTITLED, "CITY COUNCIL," OF TITLE 1, ENTITLED, "ADMINISTRATIVE," OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF EAST MOLINE, ILLINOIS OF 1974, AS AMENDED.**

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**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of East Moline, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1-5-10, entitled "Rules of Order," of Chapter 5, entitled "City Council," of Title 1, entitled "Administrative," of the City Code of the City of East Moline, Illinois of 1974, as amended, is hereby amended, by the adoption of a new paragraph (L) to be entitled "Public Comment," to read as follows:

Public Comment:

- (a) A public comment period not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes will be held during the first regularly scheduled City Council meeting of the month.
- (b) Anyone desiring to address the City Council must complete and submit a public comment card available in the City Council Chambers up to fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of the meeting. The person must include his or her name and contact information.
- (c) There shall be a maximum of five (5) speakers in any public comment period. In the event more than five (5) public comment cards are submitted, the Mayor shall randomly select the five (5) speakers. Comments are limited to three (3) minutes per speaker. A speaker can not give his or her allotted minutes to another speaker to increase that person's allotted time.
- (d) Speakers will be acknowledged by the Mayor and shall address the City Council in a respectful manner from the podium and not approach the City Council or City staff. Speakers will begin their statement by first stating their name and address for the record.
- (e) Statements are to be directed to the City Council as a whole and not to individual Council members or individual City staff. Public comment is not intended to require Council members or City staff to provide any answer to the speaker. Discussions between speakers and members of the audience will not be allowed.
- (f) After the speaker has made his or her statement, he or she shall be seated with no further debate, dialogue or comment.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed, insofar as they do so conflict.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication thereof, as required by law.
